



## Pick Up a Fundraiser This Fall

Raise money for neuroblastoma initiatives and raise awareness at the same time with one of the following fundraising ideas. They're easy to do, and CNCF will support you with signage, collateral material and volunteers, and help you spread the word out.

**Coins4Kids** is an excellent way to get school districts and kids involved in the fight against neuroblastoma. Entire school districts, single schools, or grade levels compete to raise the most money in loose change. This year's campaign slogan is "Save change - change lives" and the annual fundraising goal is \$25,000. CNCF can provide Coins4Kids flyers and letters to send to district or school officials seeking their participation. Schools are encouraged to provide an incentive for students to participate, such as a pizza party, extra credit, or special recognition during an assembly for the top earning classrooms.

**Lanyards.** Children in the Houston area have made hundreds of lanyards in memory of an NB angel, Erin Buenger and her friend, Hans Weberling, who continues to struggle with the disease. The lanyards are great for teachers, places of business where you have to wear a name tag, hospitals, banks, etc. They come in bundles of 20 and the price is \$20 per lanyard, or 2 for \$30.

**Donation cards.** Patrons at restaurants, retailers, car repair shops and grocery stores can make a small donation and have their name displayed on the donation card in the store.
